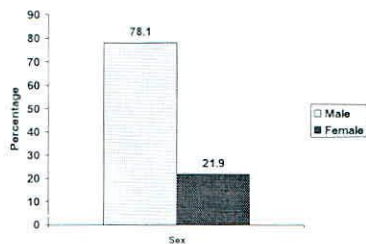

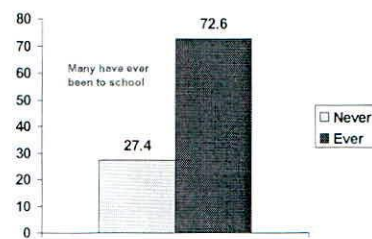

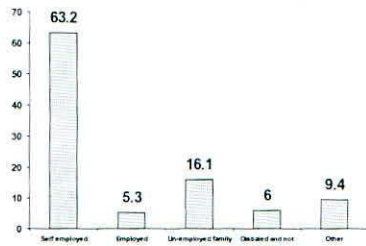

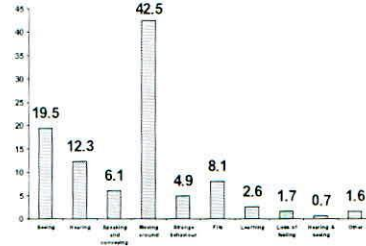

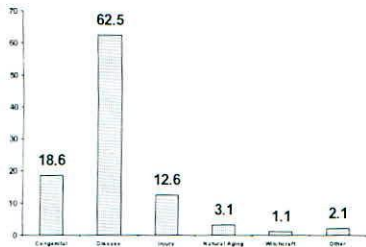

Type of Disability



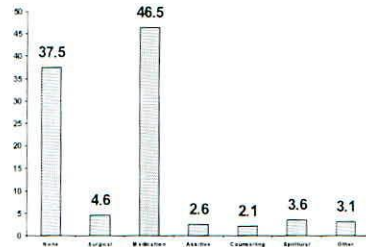

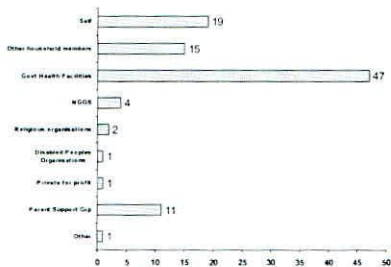

Key Findings

- The most common disability is difficult in Moving around account for 4 in every 10 disabilities reported
- Diseases were the leading cause of disability, ie more than half of the disabilities.
- Medication was the most common remedy to overcome the disabilities.
- Government health facilities were providing most of the rehabilitation.
